Polar Bear

The Polar Bear (*Ursus Maritimus*) is a hyper carnivorous mammal and a member of the Ursidae family. Polar bears are native to the arctic circle and are the largest bear species and land carnivore. Polar bears are born on land but spend most of their time searching for and hunting seals on the sea ice. Polar bears are not territorial and spend much of their adult lives alone. Groups of polar bears are known as sloths or a sleuth of bears; male bears are known as boars, females as sows, and the young as cubs. **Interesting Fact:** Polar Bears are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours, typically male-male



Horses

The Horse (*Equus Ferus Caballus*) is a herbivorous mammal and a member of the Equidae family. Horses are prey animals, forming groups known as harras or teams. Horses are intelligent, curious, alert, possess great speed and balance, and are instinctual, with the fight or flight response. Horses are herd animals with a clear hierarchy, typically with the dominant female known as a mare. The older male horses are known as stallions, and the younger male horses are known as colts. The males, other mares, younger female horses, known as fillies and the youngest of the group, known as foals, all form part of the herd, following the social structure under the matriarch. Horses are highly social animals and form close bonds with other horses and humans. They communicate through vocalisations such as nickering or whinnying, mutual grooming and their body language. **Interesting Fact:** Horses are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours, typically male-male

Giraffe

The Giraffe (*Giraffa*) is a herbivorous mammal and a member of the Giraffidae family. Giraffes are the tallest living animal on land on earth and ruminant. The giraffe is a mammal that gets nutrients from plant-based foods by fermenting, typically over 35 kilos of food each day. Giraffes are native to Africa and inhabit the savannahs and woodlands. Giraffes are social animals that live in herds of ten to twenty, known as towers. Male giraffes known as boars live in bachelor herds, with the more dominant males gaining mating access to females, known as cows. Once a female gives birth to her calf, she is responsible for raising it on her own.

Interesting Fact: Giraffes are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours, typically male-male. There are high levels and frequencies of same-sex behaviours, higher than heterosexual relationships, typically starting with aggressive necking and caressing one another.

The Chimpanzee (*Pan Troglodytes*) is a species of ape found in Africa's forests and savannahs. Chimpanzees are mammals and part of the Hominidae family.

Chimpanzees are omnivorous, preferring fruits, seeds, and plants; however, they are also known to eat insects, smaller primates and warthogs. A group of chimpanzees are known as a troop; a male chimpanzee is known as a boar. A female is known as an empress, and the young are known as infants.

Interesting Fact: Dwarf chimpanzees form part of a matriarchal society, in which bisexual relationships and behaviours are commonplace amongst the troop. The behaviour occurs more frequently between the female group members, as it is a form of bonding ritual or system.

Gray Whale

The Gray Whale (*Eschrichtius Robustus*) is a carnivorous mammal and a member of the Eschrichtiidae family. Grey whales live in oceans of the eastern section of the North Pacific (North America), the western part of the North Pacific (Asia) and rare sightings in the North Atlantic (Europe). Gray whales stay close to the shoreline and feed in the shallow waters, mainly feeding on benthic crustaceans found on the sea bed. The Gray whale travels in groups known as pods, with males known as bulls, females known as cows and the young as calves.

Interesting Fact: Groups of Gray whales in the wild are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours. Two or more male Gray whales will roll in the ocean to touch their bellies and genitals.

Flamingo

The Flamingo (*Phoenicopterus Ruber*) is an omnivorous bird and a member of the Phoenicopteridae family. There are four species found throughout the Americas, Africa, Asia and Europe. Flamingos get their distinct colour from their food, from small insects, crustaceans such as shrimp to blue-green algae. Flamingos are highly social birds with their colonies, known as pats, often containing populations of thousands. Both males and females are known as flamingos and the young as chicks. **Interesting Fact:** Flamingos are known sometimes to form committed same-sex relationships, including travelling, living, raising their young and engaging in sexual same-sex relationships and behaviours

Lion

The Lion (*Panthera Leo*) is a carnivorous mammal and a member of the Felidae family. Lions are native to Africa and some parts of Asia. Lions are a social species forming groups known as prides. A pride is comprised of a few male lions, many lionesses (the name for the female of the species) and their young cubs (the name for the young of the species). Lions are apex predators on land amongst the grasslands and savannas of Africa, and usually, groups of females hunt together.

Interesting Fact: Both male and female lions are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours. Often, relationships are seen as a bonding ritual or system. The process will last many days, in which the dominant male will initiate the activity with nuzzling and caressing, leading ultimately to mounting the more passive lion.



Dolphin

The Dolphin (Delphinus) is a carnivorous mammal and a member of the Artiodactyla family. Dolphins are considered one of the world's most intelligent and highly social animals. Dolphins will often live in groups, known as pods, made up of dozens of males, known as boars and females, known as cows. Dolphins typically feed on fish and squid. Male dolphins will typically mate with multiple females every year; however, female dolphins will only mate every two to three years. Young dolphins are known as calves, and the dolphin's distinctive colour helps them conceal themselves from predators. **Interesting Fact:** Dolphins are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours, typically displaying bisexual attributes. There are reports of Amazon Dolphins engaging in sexual activity in groups of three to five, mainly made up of young males.

Dragonfly

The Dragonfly (Anisoptera) is a carnivorous insect and a member of the Odonata order. Dragonflies can be found living in every continent and country except Antarctica. They are also both agile fliers and effective predators. Dragonflies are made up of bright and metallic colours, making them noticeable while in flight. Male dragonflies, known as boars, are often territorial. Dragonflies will eat various insects, including small midges, mosquitoes, butterflies, moths, damselflies, and even smaller dragonflies. Male populations tend to inhabit wetlands, whilst females, known as queens, prefer drier meadows. Young dragonflies are known as nymphs, and large groups are known as swarms. **Interesting Fact:** Dragonflies inflict damage to females' heads during sex. Studies into mating rituals found that high percentages of male dragonflies had evidence of the same head injury, meaning that same-sex relationships and behaviours were commonplace.



Orca Whale

The Orca Whale (*Orcinus Orca*), also known as the killer whale, is a carnivorous mammal and a member of the Delphinidae, part of the dolphin family. Orca whales are apex predators within the oceans and hunt and feed on fish, seals, dolphins, whale calves and even adult whales. Orca Whales are highly social and intelligent, forming groups known as pods. Their impressive hunting techniques and vocal behaviours are passed down through their pods. Orca whales can be found in all oceans and seas and travel over large areas. Pods are matriarchal, with male whales known as bulls living with their mothers, the females known as cows, for their whole lives. Young Orca whales are known as calves.

Interesting Fact: Orca Whales are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours, typically male-male



Koala

The Koala Bear (*Phascolarctos Cinereus*) is a herbivorous mammal and a member of the Phascolarctidae family. The Koala is native only to Australia and feeds mainly on the leaves of the eucalypt trees. Koalas are asocial and sedentary animals, sleeping up to 20 hours each day. Most are solitary and only form bonds between the mothers and offspring. Koala bears have very few natural predators; however, the biggest killer is bacteria and diseases that continuously threaten the Koala colonies. Male koalas, known as boars, use large bellows to scare off other koalas from their territories and attract female mates, which are known as does. The young koalas are known as joeys. **Interesting Fact:** Koala Bears are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours, male-male and female-female.



Penguin

The Penguin (Pinguinus) is a carnivorous bird and a member of the Sphenisciformes family. Penguins live exclusively in the Southern Hemisphere and can be found in Angola, Antarctica, Argentina, Australia, Chile, Namibia, New Zealand and South Africa. Penguins feed on krill, fish, squid and other sea life, are highly social and breed in large colonies. The large groups are known as colonies or rookeries, male penguins are known as boars, females are known as hens, and the young are known as chicks or nestlings. **Interesting Fact:** Penguins are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours, typically male-male. There are recorded observations of same-sex penguin behaviours as early as 1911


