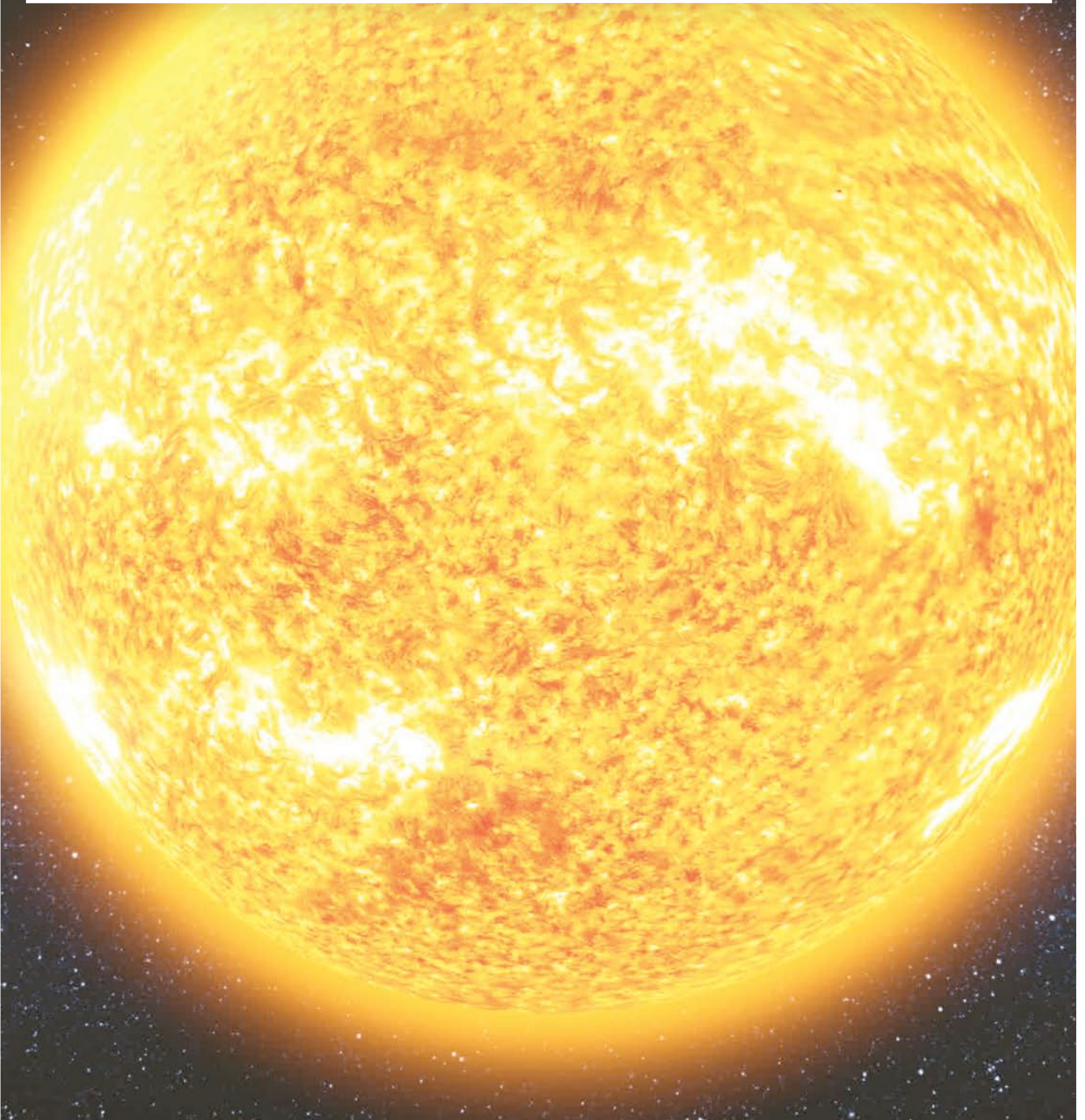

It is believed to have formed over 4.8 billion years ago and is often considered the planet or star of self. The Sun is associated with the sun gods, Helios and Ra. 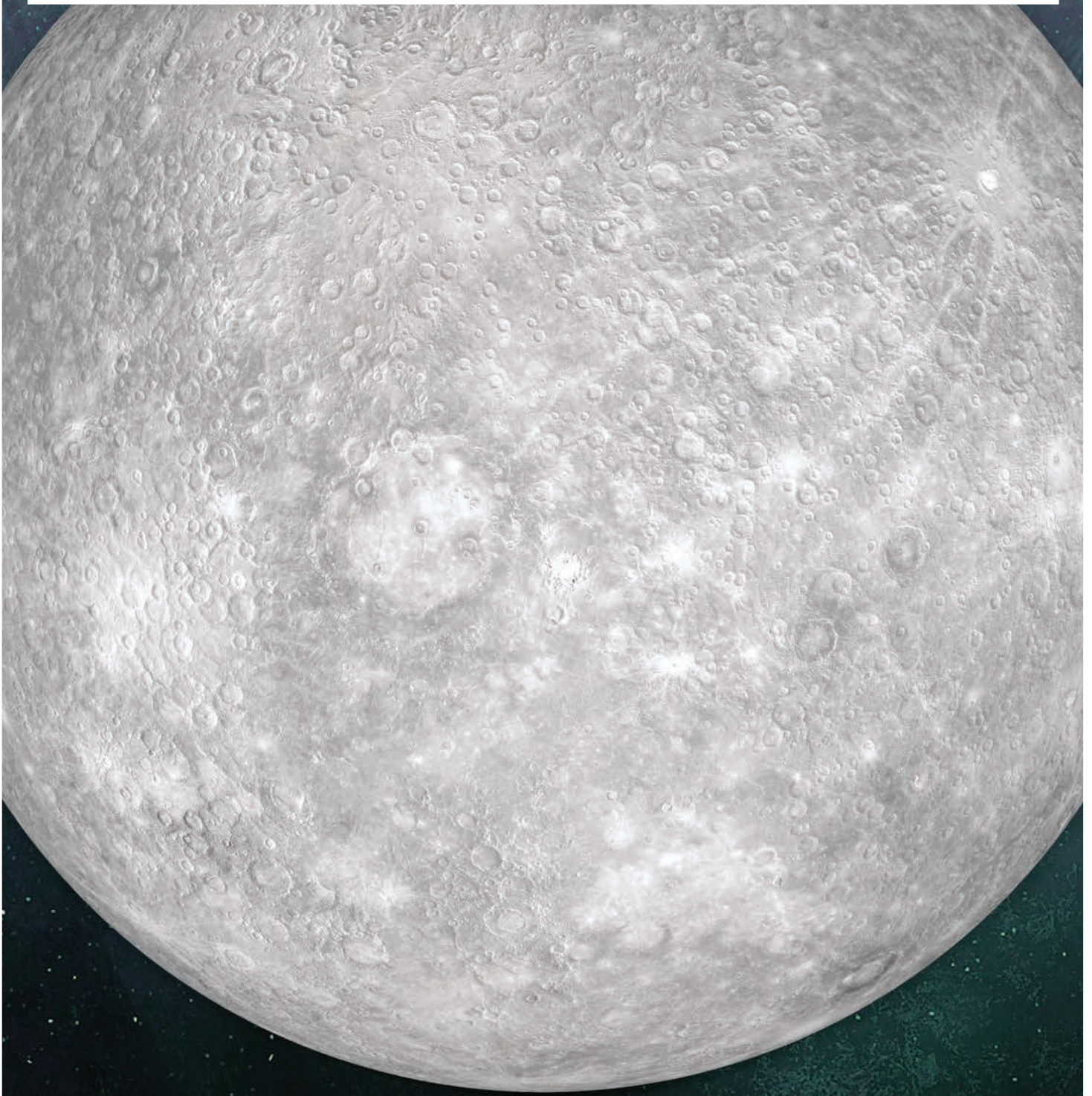

The Sun or solar symbol has been used throughout history in religious and personifications of the Sun. The emblem represents a halo or a radiated crown. It is also related to the day of the week, Sunday and the metal gold.



Mercury

The planet Mercury is the smallest and closest to the Sun. The planet was named after Mercury, a Roman deity and the messenger of the gods. Within astrology, it is associated with the star signs Gemini and Virgo and is often considered the planet of communication. Mercury is personified as reason, communication, emotions, logic and rationality. The planet, from a gender perspective, is seen as transitional, so neither male nor female. **The LGBTQIA+ connection is Mercury is linked to male eunuchs, transwomen and those that identify as Intersex. In addition, the symbol for Mercury is used by the transgender community.** Ultimately Mercury is about dark and light, reason, logic and communication

The symbol for Mercury is represented as a staff with two serpents intertwined. It is associated with the herald of the Greek gods, Hermes and also used as a symbol for intersex, transgender or non-binary genders. It is also related to the day of the week, Wednesday and the metal mercury



Venus

The planet Venus is the second planet from the Sun and is referred to as the sister or twin planet to the Earth. The planet was named after the Roman Goddess Venus, who represented love, beauty, desire, sex, fertility, prosperity, and victory. Within astrology, it is associated with the star signs Libra and Taurus and is often considered the planet of love and money. Venus is personified as beauty, pleasure, love, harmony, sociability and abundance. The planet is seen as having feminine or female identities. **The LGBTQIA+ connection is the symbol for Venus and is typically doubled and used to represent the lesbian community.** Ultimately Venus is about love, harmony and abundance

The Earth

The Earth is the third planet from the Sun. It is the only place in the known universe that is habitable and where life has originated. The word for Earth formed from the old English term, Eorde, meaning ground or soil. It is also referred to as Terra, after the Roman Goddess Terra or the Greek Goddess Gaia, who is the personification of Mother Earth. Within astrology, it is associated with the three earth star signs, Taurus, Virgo and Capricorn and is often considered the planet of fertility, creativity and longevity. The planet is seen as having a feminine or female identities. **Though there is no direct LGBTQIA+ connection, it is associated with feminine gender identities.** Ultimately the Earth is about life and fertility

The symbol for the Earth is a circle with a cross inside and represents the world divided by four rivers or quarters (four corners of the world). The Earth god is Gaia or Terra, the ancestral mother or bringer of life. The Earth rotates around the Sun and is closer in early January and farther away in July



The Moon

The Moon is the fourth mass from the Sun. Technically, the Moon is not a planet but a natural satellite that orbits the Earth, the fifth largest in our solar system. The word for the Moon formed from the old English term, mona, meaning a measure of time. It is also called Luna and is associated with many deities, including the Greek Goddesses Artemis, Selene and the Roman Goddesses Diana and Luna. Within astrology, it is associated with the star sign Cancer and is often considered the planet of emotions. The Moon is often seen as feminine or female identities and is personified as feelings, emotions, imagination and our inner selves. **Though there is no direct LGBTQIA+ connection, it is associated with feminine gender identities.** Ultimately the Moon represents our inner self, thoughts and feelings

The Moon is associated with many deities, including the Roman Goddesses Luna and Selene and the Greek goddesses Diana and Artemis. It is also related to the day of the week, Monday and the metal silver



Mars

The planet Mars is the fourth planet from the Sun and is referred to as the son of the Earth. The planet was named after the Roman God of war, Mars, who represented action, determination, and aggression. Within astrology, it is associated with the star sign Aries and is often considered the planet of passion. The planet is seen as having masculine or male identities. **The LGBTQIA+ connection is the symbol for Mars and is typically doubled and used to represent the Gay community.** Ultimately Mars is about passion, competition and determination

The symbol for Mars is used to represent the male sex and those with male identities. It is also related to the day of the week, Tuesday and the metal iron



Ceres

The dwarf planet Ceres was initially classified as an asteroid, the only one orbiting entirely within Neptune's orbit. The planet was named after the Roman Goddess of Agriculture, Ceres, who represents motherhood, family relationships, transitions in a woman's life and agriculture. Within astrology, it is associated with the star sign Taurus and is often considered the planet of the family. The planet is seen as having a feminine or female identities. **Though there is no direct LGBTQIA+ connection, it is associated with feminine gender identities.** Ultimately Ceres is about all things relating to the family, including motherhood and nurturing

The symbol for Ceres is depicted as a reaper's sickle. The planet and symbol were named after Ceres, the Roman goddess of agriculture. The dwarf planet is located within the asteroid belt between Mars and Jupiter. In late 2014, two bright spots were seen inside a crater. The spots indicate a material such as water, ice or salt.



Jupiter

Jupiter is the seventh planet from the Sun and the largest planet in our solar system. The planet was named after the Roman God of the sky and thunder. Jupiter, like the Greek God Zeus, was the King of all the gods and, within Roman life, was believed to have been the god that oversaw all aspects of life. The planet has a colossal presence and importance in the solar system. Within astrology, it is associated with the star sign Sagittarius and is often considered the planet of luck. The planet is seen as having masculine or male identities. **Though there is no direct LGBTQIA+ connection, it is associated with masculine gender identities.** Ultimately Jupiter represents purpose, optimism, faith and fortune

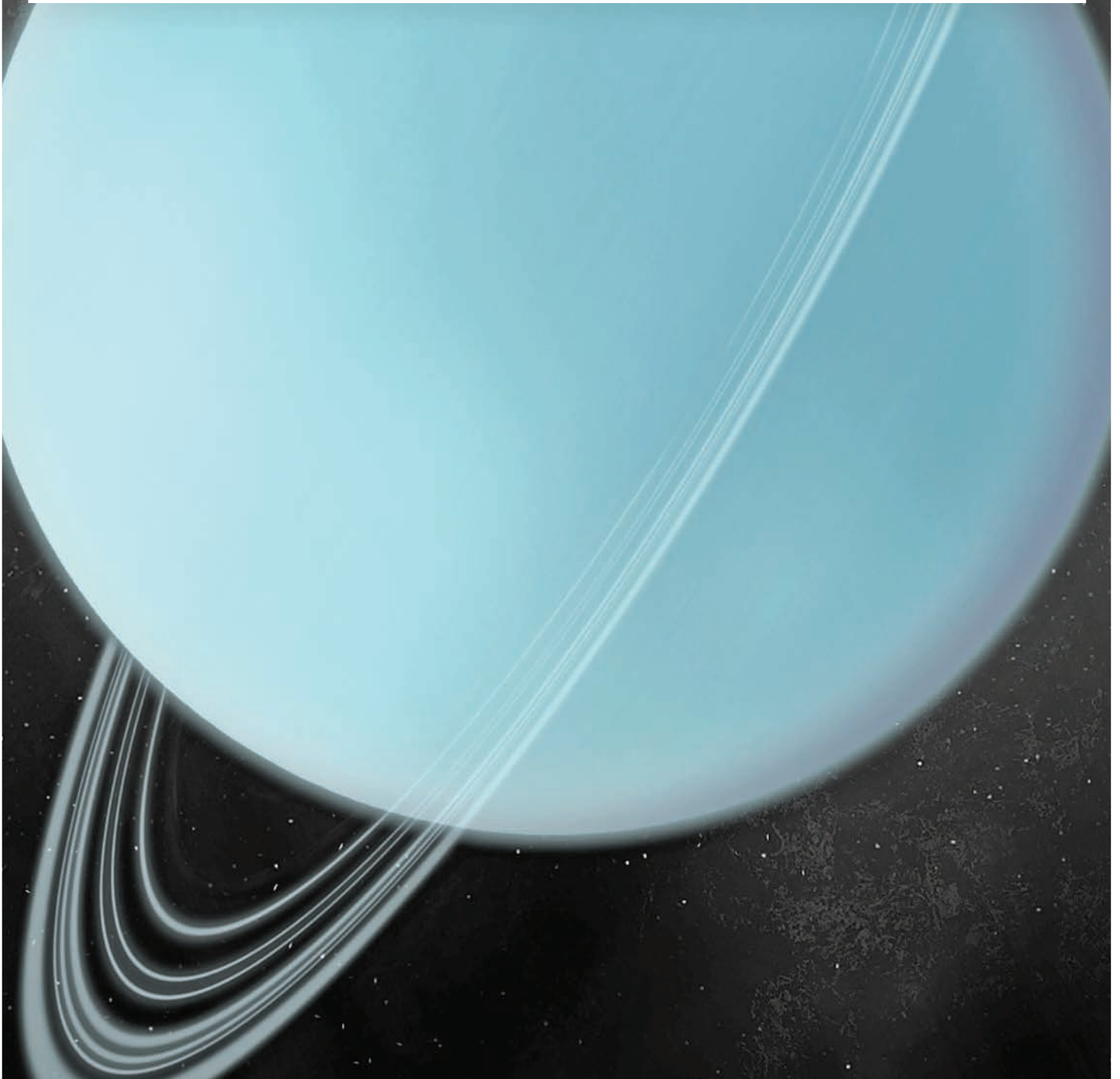

The planet is seen as having masculine or male identities. **The LGBTQIA+ connection is that according to Greek mythology, Uranus is androgynous, as his son Cronus castrated Uranus while revolting against his regime and dumped the severed organ in the sea.** Ultimately Uranus is about breaking away from tradition, determination and inspiration

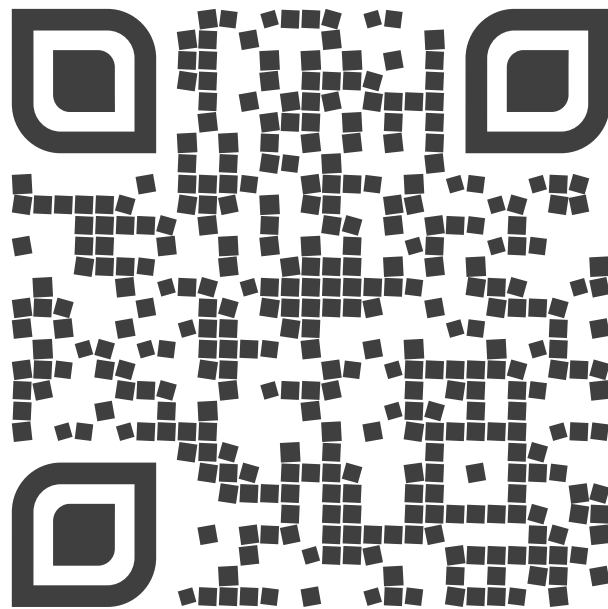
