An agender person is someone who identifies as not having or conforming to a conventional definition of gender. An agender individual may present themselves in different ways, in both how they appear and communicate (through the use of pronouns, gender identity on documents, etc.). Agender individuals cannot identify with or connect to the traditional definitions of a specific gender, such as what is male or female. Agender people may also identify as gender-neutral, genderless, or non-binary.

SUMMARY

- Individuals who do not identify or conform to a conventional definition of gender
- They may present themselves differently in how they appear and communicate.
- Agender people may also identify as gender-neutral, genderless or non-binary.

TAKE PRIDE

Acceptance and coming to terms with how a person chooses to identify or love, especially in accepting it themselves, is often challenging. Self-discovery is typically one of the most significant steps a person from the LGBTQIA+ community can take. The acceptance process can be complex and made worse when we can not associate, connect or identify with others similar to ourselves. Failing to find a positive representative can make a person feel disconnected, isolated and alone.



The pride in series is about educating and sharing information about various identities, sexualities and special groups. It is a platform that showcases and highlights the exceptional groups of individuals that make up the global community and hopefully helps people feel pride. Learning more about people similar to yourself not only helps debunk misinformation but can also help change perceptions and, ultimately, help people take pride in their community or communities, whatever they might be.

You should never feel or be told that being different is wrong. It does not matter if you are straight, gay, or any of the other no-traditional sexual or gender identities. You are you, especially when it is your identity and something you cannot change.

INTERESTING STATISTICS

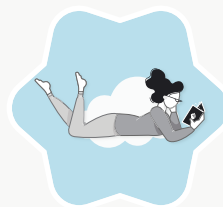
- Agender is not rare; more people are identifying as agender as the world encourages everyone to be express how they think and feel
- Agender means 'someone without gender', meaning unable to identify as male, female or anywhere else on the gender spectrum
- Being Agender does not mean that a person is asexual, many agender individuals experience sexual desires and attractions
- Many Agender individuals use gender pronouns; however, others opt for specific genderless pronouns such as they or them
- Agender is not the same as non-binary or genderfluid, as agender is about a person not being able to identify as neither male nor female. In contrast, genderfluid is about moving across the spectrum, and non-binary is about not being exclusively masculine or feminine and being outside of the gender binary. It is not uncommon though for some agender people to also identify as non-binary

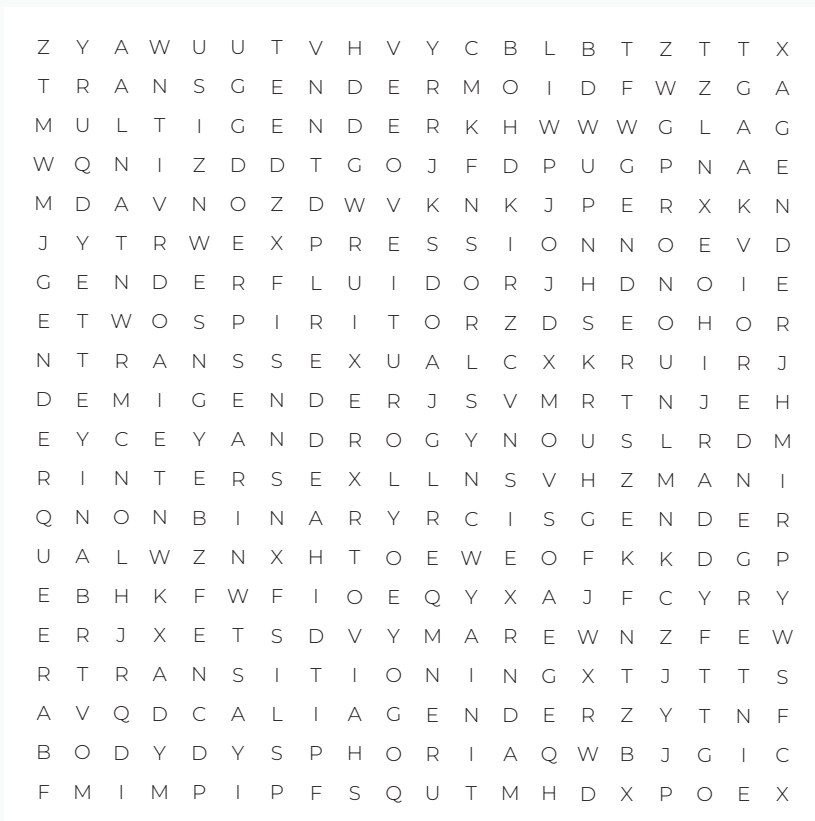

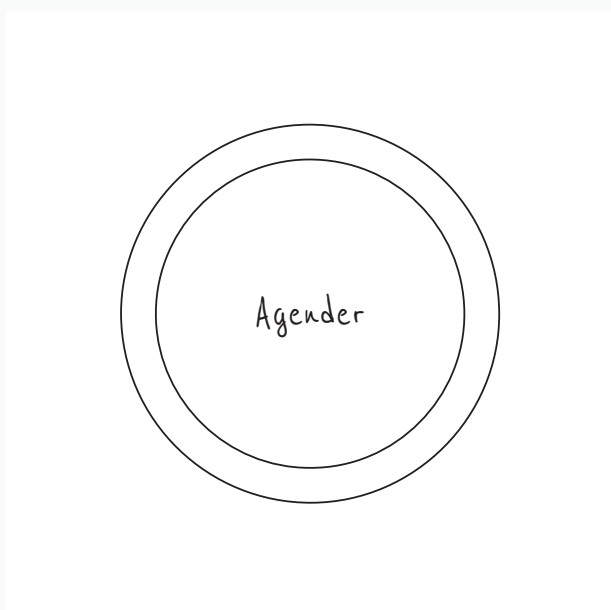

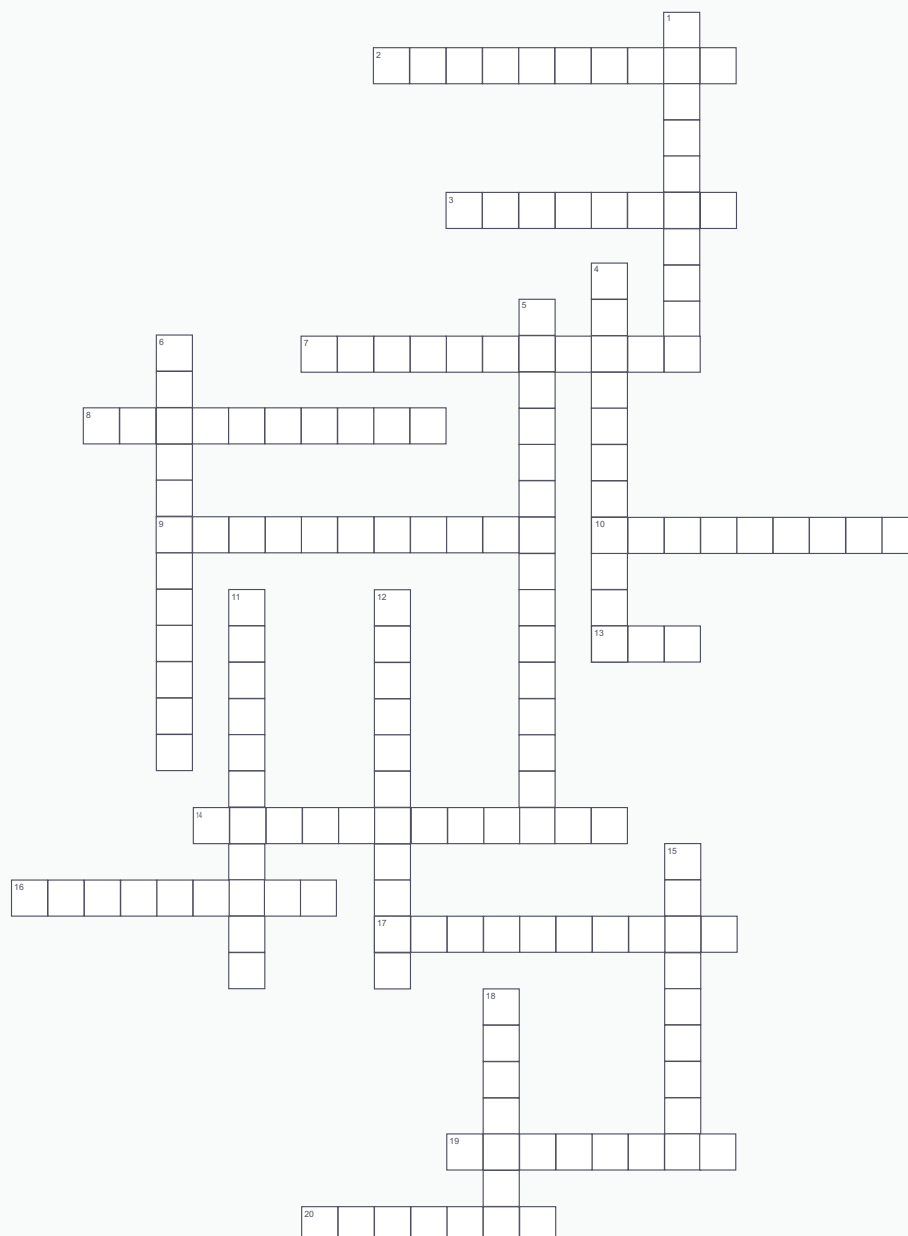

The agender symbol is represented by a circle, which typically represents completeness. The symbol does not feature the male or female indicators to reflect that agender individuals do not identify as male or female.
