A bisexual individual can be defined as someone who is male, female, within the spectrum or non-binary. Bisexual people are physically, emotionally and/or sexually attracted to individuals from both the same and opposite genders (male-female-male, female-male-female). Unlike those who identify as gay or lesbian, Bisexuals generally do not prefer one gender over the other. Bisexual individuals will often be referred to as bi or pan.

OTHER ASSOCIATED SEXUAL IDENTIFIERS

- Bicurious (pronounced bahy-kyoor-ee-uhs | bʌt'kjʊəJIəs) is a term referring to an individual who is attracted to the opposite sex; however, is also experiencing attraction to a person who is the same gender as themselves. Though experiencing attraction, they would not have yet had sexual relations or acted on their attraction.

TAKE PRIDE

Acceptance and coming to terms with how a person chooses to identify or love, especially in accepting it themselves, is often challenging. Selfdiscovery is typically one of the most significant steps a person from the LGBTQIA+ community can take. The acceptance process can be complex and made worse when we can not associate, connect or identify with others similar to ourselves. Failing to find a positive representative can make a person feel disconnected, isolated and alone.

The pride in series is about educating and sharing information about various identities, sexualities and special groups. It is a platform that showcases and highlights the exceptional groups of individuals that make up the global community and hopefully helps people feel pride. Learning more about people similar to yourself not only helps debunk misinformation but can also help change perceptions and, ultimately, help people take pride in their community or communities, whatever they might be.

You should never feel or be told that being different is wrong. It does not matter if you are straight, gay, or any of the other no-traditional sexual or gender identities. You are you, especially when it is your identity and something you cannot change.

- It is believed that 1.3% of men and 2.2% of women around the world identify as Bisexual, making them the largest group within the LGBTQ+ community
- Bisexuality has been around for thousands of years and is referenced in numerous religious texts and scriptures from ancient Greece, Rome, Japan and China
- People born since 1965 are more likely to not identify as entirely straight or gay
- People of colour are more likely to be bisexual than Caucasians
- Bisexuals are more likely to be attracted to people from across the gender spectrum than other members of the LGBTQ+ community






