A gay individual can be defined as someone who is male, within the spectrum or as non-binary; however, will typically be assigned male at birth. Gay men are physically, emotionally and/or sexually attracted to individuals from the same gender/sex (male-male). The term gay is also used to describe people who identify as LGBTQIA+ and is not exclusively used concerning gay men. The word gay means happy and a rascal and was used by the LGBTQIA+ community in the 20th century to communicate their sexuality in public without being exposed. The medical term relating to gay people is a homosexual male.

TAKE PRIDE



Acceptance and coming to terms with how a person chooses to identify or love, especially in accepting it themselves, is often challenging. Self-discovery is typically one of the most significant steps a person from the LGBTQIA+ community can take. The acceptance process can be complex and made worse when we can not associate, connect or identify with others similar to ourselves. Failing to find a positive representative can make a person feel disconnected, isolated and alone.

The pride in series is about educating and sharing information about various identities, sexualities and special groups. It is a platform that showcases and highlights the exceptional groups of individuals that make up the global community and hopefully helps people feel pride. Learning more about people similar to yourself not only helps debunk misinformation but can also help change perceptions and, ultimately, help people take pride in their community or communities, whatever they might be.

You should never feel or be told that being different is wrong. It does not matter if you are straight, gay, or any of the other no-traditional sexual or gender identities. You are you, especially when it is your identity and something you cannot change.

INTERESTING STATISTICS

- Without an official census, conservative estimates predict that under 1% of men around the world identify as Gay; however, some estimates are as high as 10%
- The word Gay originally was an English term that meant, joyful, carefree, bright and showy. The name was later used for homosexual men, as a way of communicating their sexuality in code
- According to Canadian researchers, men with older brother are three times more likely to be gay than those with no older brothers; which resulted in the term the 'big brother effect.'
- Billy Haines was the first movie actor who was publicly and openly gay in 1933
- · In the 1950s, the LGBT community tried to change the term 'homosexual' to 'homophile', to emphasise same-gender love rather than sex






