The Penguin (*Pinguinus*) is a carnivorous bird and a member of the Sphenisciformes family. Penguins live exclusively in the Southern Hemisphere and can be found in Angola, Antarctica, Argentina, Australia, Chile, Namibia, New Zealand and South Africa. Penguins feed on krill, fish, squid and other sea life, are highly social and breed in large colonies. The large groups are known as colonies or rookeries, male penguins are known as boars, females are known as hens, and the young are known as chicks or nestlings.

Interesting Fact: Penguins are known to engage in same-sex relationships and behaviours, typically male-male. There are recorded observations of same-sex penguin behaviours as early as 1911
