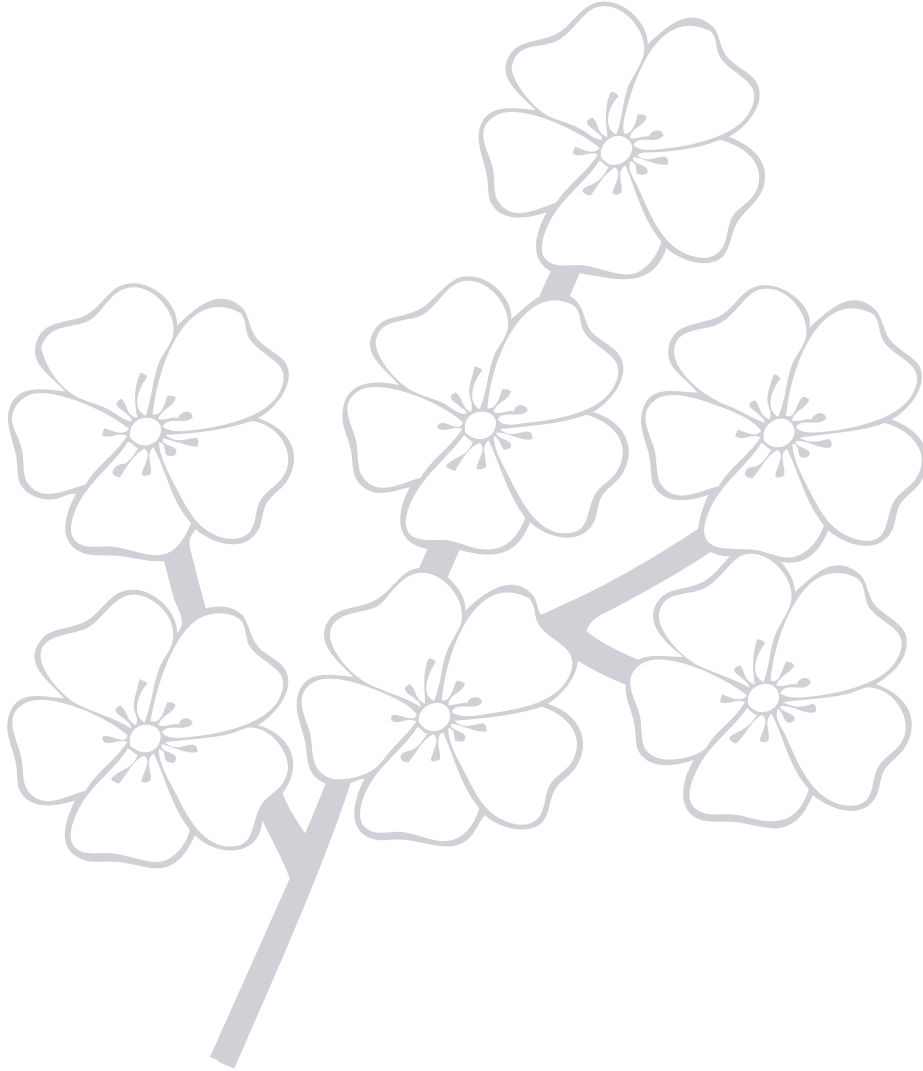

The Cherry Blossom, Japanese Cherry or Sakura is a flowering tree. The most common variety is the Somei-Yoshino cherry tree, with many species in Eastern Asia, especially Japan. The petals of the cherry blossom are edible, and the tree typically only blooms for one week in late march to early April.
