


SATURN 09

Saturn is the sixth planet from the Sun and the second largest planet in our solar system. The planet was named after the Roman god of wealth and agriculture, Saturn, who was also the father of Jupiter. Within astrology, it is associated with the star sign Capricorn and is often considered the planet of karma. The planet, from a gender perspective, is seen as transitional, so neither male nor female. **The LGBTQIA+ connection is Saturn is linked to female eunuchs, transmen and those identifying as Lesbian and Transgender.** In Hinduism legend, it was the Goddess Saturn or Shani, who was a lesbian and who married a woman.
