


URANUS 10

Uranus is the seventh planet from the Sun and has the third-largest diameter in our solar system. The planet is the only one in our solar system named after a Greek God, Uranus. In Greek mythology, the sky deity Uranus is the father of Cronus and grandfather to Zeus. He represents intuition, inspiration and insight, determination, and aggression. Within astrology, it is associated with the star sign Aquarius and is often considered the planet of rebellion. The planet is seen as having masculine or male identities. The LGBTQIA+ connection is that according to Greek mythology, Uranus is androgynous, as his son Cronus castrated Uranus while revolting against his regime and dumped the severed organ in the sea.
