Lanthanum is a chemical element with the symbol La and has the atomic number 57. The term originates from ancient Greek, *λανθάνειν*, meaning to lie hidden, given that the component is an impurity in cerium nitrate. The element was discovered in 1839. It is a soft, silvery-white metal that tarnishes when exposed to the air. It is a rare earth element and is typically used in catalysts, additives in glass, lamps, ignition elements, electron cathodes, and gas tungsten in welding, which are just some of its uses.
