Uranium is a chemical element with the symbol U and has the atomic number 92. The element was named after the planet Uranus, which was discovered eight years before the element in 1781. Uranium is a silvery-grey metal with the highest atomic weight of primordially occurring elements and a density 70% higher than lead. Uranium is typically used for fuel within nuclear power plants and the nuclear reactors that power naval ships and submarines.
