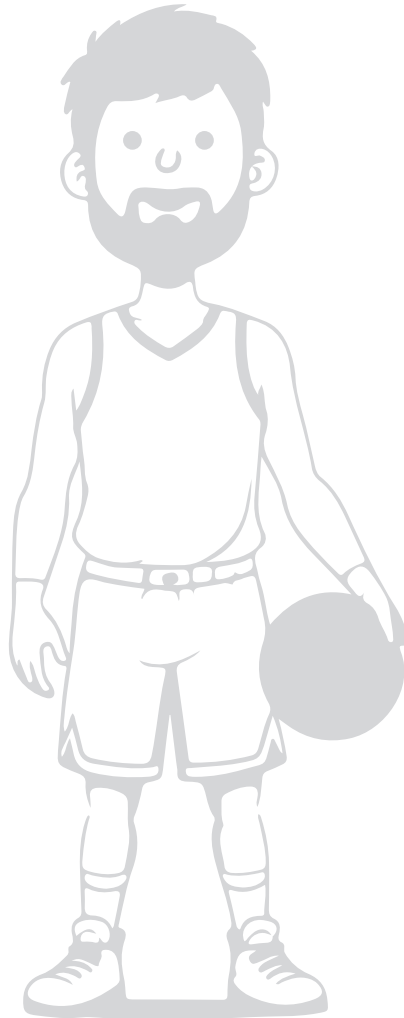

The sport involves players using their hands to dribble, pass, and employ strategy and skill, with the winning team being the one that scores the most during the 48 minutes of actual playing time. The sport was created in 1891 by Dr James Naismith, a physical education instructor in Massachusetts, USA, as an indoor activity and a way to keep his students active during the winter months.
