Rugby is a team sport with 15 players on each side (in Rugby Union) or 13 players (in Rugby League) and is characterised by running, passing, and tackling to score points by grounding the ball in the opponent's in-goal area, emphasising teamwork, strength, and strategic play. Rugby originated in England, with its roots often traced back to 1823 and the student William Webb Ellis, who created a new style of play which was based on the sport of football.



INTERESTING FACT

The oldest International Rugby Trophy is the Calcutta Cup, which dates back to 1872, and the trophy was made from Indian Silver Rupees.
